

INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

Northwestern Connecticut Community College complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 by providing appropriate accommodations for students with disabilities to level the playing field for their success.

- Students have the right to choose to identify themselves as having disabilities, to participate in the decisions about their accommodations, and to have records released only with their written consent.
- Students have the responsibility to provide documentation of their disabilities, to request accommodations in a timely manner, and to assume their responsibilities for the success of their accommodations.
