Course Title: Sign Vocabulary

Course #: ASL* 100

Course Description: 3 credits

A general elective course focusing on sign language vocabulary and fingerspelling. This course is open to any student who is interested in developing basic sign language communication skills.

Pre-requisite/Co-requisite: None

Goals: For students to develop sign language vocabulary
For students to develop a better understanding of Deaf culture.

Outcomes: Upon successful completion of the course students should be able to:

1. communicate with Deaf people
2. demonstrate a better understanding of, and sensitivity to American Deaf culture.
